Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of construction work of Lalitpur-Singrauli to Khajuraho rail line via Tikamgarh;
- (b) the details of amount sanctioned, allocated and spent on said project so far; and
- (c) the time by which the said project is likely to be completed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c) :- "Lalitpur-Satna, Mahoba-Khajuraho and Rewa-Singrauli" is a 541 Km long new rail line project on which Mahoba-Khajuraho (65 Km) portion has already been completed and commissioned. Lalitpur-Udaipura (32 Km) section is expected to be completed shortly. Target date of completion for the remaining portion of the project has not yet been fixed. The work is being progressed as per availability of resources. An outlay of Rs 100 crore was provided for this work for 2010-11. Till December 2010 an expenditure of Rs 482.65 crore has been incurred on this project.
