Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Railways have received representations for the construction of manned railway crossing on various sections in Bhiwani-Mahendergarh to check the increasing number of accidents on such railway sections;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Railways in each of such case?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c) Representations have been received for retaining level crossing number 33C after construction of Road Over Bridge (ROB) at Charkhi-Dadri, provision of manned level crossing gates at km. 24/11-12 between Charaud-Siwani at km. 188 between Oparvezpur and Rampura Beri and at km. 32/14-15 between Kathuws and Ateli. However proliferation of level crossings are not desirable being a potential Safety hazard. Subways at technically suitable locations can be considered, if the State Government sponsors the same on deposit terms.
