**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has conducted any evaluation of the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) since its inception;
- (b) if so, the outcome thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether SSA has failed to achieve its targets;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and the reasons therefor;
- (e) the funds allocated and spent on SSA during the last three years and the current year, year-wise, State-wise; and
- (f) the steps taken or being taken by the Government for effective implementation of SSA?

**Answer**

- (a): Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) programme is reviewed every six month by the Joint Review Mission (JRM). The JRM held between 19.01.2011 to 30.01.2011 has found the progress of SSA satisfactory.
- (b) to (d): Till 2009-10, 3,03,002 schools have been opened, 2,49,542 school buildings have been constructed, 10,30,201 teachers have been recruited under SSA. State- wise details are given in Annexure-I.
- (e) & (f): The details of funds provided to States/UTs for effective implementation of SSA programme during the last three years and current year are given in the Annexure-II.
