- (f) In order to scale up efforts for population stabilization and more specifically meet the substantial unmet need, the various initiatives taken by the Government includes introduction of National Family Planning Insurance Scheme (NFPIS) to compensate sterilization acceptors for failures, complications and deaths and indemnity insurance cover to doctors; enhancement of compensation packages for sterilization; promotion of IUD-380A intensively as a spacing method because of its longevity; encouraging fixed-place family planning services and increasing the basket of choice by systematically and carefully introducing new and effective contraceptives in the programme.
