Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has formulated any scheme to provide the antisnake venom injection and anti-rabies injection in the rural areas under the National Rural Health Mission by setting up of special fund;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has received any complaints of unavailability of anti-venom and anti-rabies injections in the rural areas at present; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the action taken by the Government in this regard?

Therefore, it is primarily the responsibility of the State Government to ensure the availability of antisnake serum and anti-rabies vaccine in the health care facilities in rural areas. However, under the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) funds are provided to states for procurement of drugs including anti-snake serum and anti-rabies vaccine in rural areas to make up for any shortages.
