(a)to(e) In order to document and prepare a database of unprotected monuments in the country including Bihar, the National Mission on Monuments and Antiquities (NMMA) has been established to prepare such a National database on monuments from secondary sources. The detail of unprotected monuments compiled by NMMA so far from secondary sources is at Annexure - I.
