(a) to (c) State Governments could not fully utilize the training slots provided by the Indian Army and Central Paramilitary Forces (CPMFs) due to operational reasons and law & order situation in the States. A statement indicating the utilization of training slots by the State Governments, according to the information available is attached.

(d) & (e) The Union Government issues directives to State Governments from time to time requesting them to utilize the training slots fully. The Chief Ministers have also been sensitized on this aspect in the Chief Ministers' Conference held on 1st February, 2011.
