- (a) the number of minority educational institutions in Kerala recognised by the Minority Education Commission so far;
- (b) whether several applications from Kerala are pending with the Commission;

- (d) whether the Government proposes to provide CBSE affiliation to those Minority Educational Institutions not having NOC from the State Government of Kerala; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) Whereas information regarding number of minority educational institutions is not maintained centrally, the National Commission for Minority Educational Institutions (NCMEI) has granted minority status to 1729 institutions of Kerala upto 15th February, 2011. Applications for grant of minority status are taken up for consideration of the Commission in accordance with its procedure.
