(a) to (d) Health being a state subject, no such information is maintained centrally. In so far as Central Government Hospital located in Delhi, namely, Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital and Lady Hardinge Medical College and its Allociate Hospitals are concerned, no fees are charged by the doctors for consultation, examination, operation and medicines except for Nursing Home patients and Maternity Nursing Home patients for investigation, room and diet. These hospitals are providing treatment to BPL patients free of cost.
