(a) to (c): As per information available, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 19.2.2011 in interlocutory applications filed in the matter of T.N. Godavarman Thirumulpad vs Union of India, have directed the Forest Survey of India (FSI) to carry out the satellite imagery in Aravalli hills in Rajasthan in co-operation with the Central Empowered Committee and the State of Rajasthan. A Report is required to be submitted to the Hon'ble Supreme Court within a period of four months, starting from 19.2.2011. FSI has commenced survey operations.
