(a) to (c) Introduction of Jabalpur-Indore Intercity Express (tri-weekly) & Indore-Kota Intercity Express

(daily), extension of Indore-Ajmer Express upto Jaipur and increase in the frequency of Indore-Udaipur Express from tri-weekly to daily have been announced in Railway Budget 2011-2012.

However, introduction of other trains from Indore is not feasible at present due to resource and operational constraints.
