- (a) whether the Government proposes to store /Conserve the water by desilting lakes situated in different parts of the country alongwith constructing dams surrounding these lakes; and
- (b) if so, the action plan prepared by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b) The Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) has undertaken a Scheme of National Lake Conservation Plan (NLCP) since June, 2001 for conservation and management of polluted and degraded lakes including desiltation, and shoreline protection in urban and semi-urban areas of the country.

The total outlay under the XI Plan towards the NLCP Scheme is Rs. 440 crore. Based on the proposals received from different States, the Ministry of Environment and Forests has so far, sanctioned projects for conservation of 61 lakes in 14 States, at a total cost of Rs. 1028.19 crore.
