(a)&(b) Twenty three properties from India are inscribed in the World Heritage List of UNESCO under cultural category, out of which nineteen sites are under control of the Archaeological Survey of India. Their details are given at Annexure I.The State-wise details of revenue/foreign exchange earned from entry fee at Centrally Protected Ticketed World Heritage Sites and other sites is given at Annexure II.
