(b): Provision of 100 escalators at major stations across Indian Railways is presently under process of procurement which includes two escalators at Secunderabad. In addition 21 more escalators, two at Tirupati, one at Guntur, five at Secunderabad, two at Hyderabad, three at Kachiguda, three at Vijayawada, three at Nellore and two at Rajahmundry, are planned.
