(a) & (b): The development, promotion, implementation of tourism projects and redressal of complaints are the responsibility of the concerned State Government/Union Territory (UT) Administration themselves. Based on the information received from the Department of Tourism, Government of Gujarat, the complaints of irregularities in tourism projects being run in Gujarat have not come to the notice of the Government yet.

(c): The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India has sanctioned 12 projects on the basis of proposals received, complete in all respect, from the State Government of Gujarat for Rs.34.47 crore during the eleventh five year Plan from 2007-08 to 2010-11(upto 30.9.2010)
