(a) & (b): Discussions on ILO Report on Decent Work for Domestic Workers were held in the 99th Session of the International Labour Conference (ILC) in Geneva in June, 2010. The Report proposed the introduction of a new standard on Decent Work for Domestic Workers in the form of a Convention supported by a Recommendation. During the discussions, Government of India had introduced an amendment to replace the words 'Convention supplemented by a Recommendation' with the word "Recommendation". The amendment was seconded by the Employers' group.
