- (c) the time by which the request is likely to be accepted?

- (a) to (b): Government of Himachal Pradesh(HP) has requested a special financial package of Rs.2500 crore in 2010-11 and Special Plan Assistance of Rs.1500 crore under the annual plan of 2011-12. These amounts are required to bridge a gap on non-plan side.
- (c) Finance Commissions are expert bodies set up under article 280 of the Constitution of India. Once accepted, by convention, the recommendations of Finance Commission are not revised.
