Information has since been collected from Ministry of Power and Department of Heavy Industry concerned with NTPC Ltd. and BHEL respectively, pointed out in the New Items dated 8th July, 2010 in 'Times of India' and dated 7th July, 2010 in 'Economic Times' Ministry of Power, the administrative Ministry of NTPC Ltd. has informed that NTPC Ltd has refuted such allegations vide 'Press Release' which appeared on 8.7.2010 in the 'Indian Express' and other newspapers. Department of Heavy Industry, the administrative Department for BHEL has intimated that no names of BHEL officials have come to notice in this regard.
