**Will the Minister of COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY be pleased to state:**

- (a) the percentage share of export oriented industrial units vis-a-vis export during the last three years, year-wise;
- (b) the foreign exchange earned through the same during the said period;
- (c) whether several economic concessions are being provided to said units; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

(a)&(b) The share of EOUs in the total export of the country during the years 2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10 is about 25.7%, 21.04% and 10% respectively. The total foreign exchange earned by the EOUs during these three years US \$ 41900 million, US \$ 38400 million and US \$ 17600 million respectively.

(c)&(d) Export Oriented Units (EOUs) are eligible for fiscal concessions which include duty free import/domestic procurement and reimbursement of Central Sales Tax (CST) on capital goods, raw materials, consumables for their production activities and corporate tax exemption on export income for a specific period.
