- (a) The State-wise details of the proposals received from various State Governments during the last three years are annexed.
- (b) to (d) Expansion of National Highway network is a continuous process and declaration of new National Highway is taken up from time to time depending upon requirement of connectivity, inter-se-priority and availability of funds. No separate provision of funds is specifically made for upgradation of roads/ State Highways into National Highways. However, the development of National Highways network is taken up under the continuing programmes.
