NH A BETWEEN ROORKEE TO DEHRADUN

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Delhi-Dehradun NH-72A Roorkee to Dehradun border upto Maa Daat passing through Kali mandir was badly damaged due to excess rainfall resulting in causing road accidents;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for repair of the said NH;
- (c) the details of funds allocated/sanctioned/released for the said purpose; and
- (d) the time by which the said constructions is likely to be started and completed?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a)to(d) The stretch from Roorkee to Dehradun border upto Maa Daat passing through Kali mandir was damaged due to rain. Ministry has sanctioned an estimate amounting to Rs.1.60 crore for repair of flood damages to be executed by Uttar Pradesh Public Works Department. The work is likely to start by the end of March 2011 and targeted for completion before the onset of next monsoon.
