- (a) whether the Government has any proposal for setting up of National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Zone Management (NCSCZM) with the support of a consortium of eleven institutions to focus on capacity building and research in Coastal Zone Management;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

- (a) and (b): The Ministry has established the National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM) under the World Bank assisted Integrated Coastal Zone Management Project. A consortium of eleven research institutions covering all the coastal States and Union Territories, has been constituted to work along with NCSCM in the area of coastal zone management.
- (c): On 24th December, 2010, a Memorandum of Association between the Ministry and Anna University, Chennai was signed to set up NCSCM.
