- (a): Government are implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) called National Bamboo Mission (NBM) in 27 States for holistic development of bamboo sector in the country since 2006-07. The objectives of the Mission are to promote growth of the bamboo sector through area-based regionally-differentiated strategies; to increase the coverage of area under bamboo in potential areas with suitable species to enhance yield; to promote marketing of bamboo and bamboo-based handicrafts; to establish convergence and synergy among stakeholders for development of bamboo; to promote, develop and disseminate technologies through a seamless blend of traditional wisdom and modern scientific knowledge; and to generate employment opportunities for skilled and unskilled persons, especially unemployed youth.
- (b): A statement showing State-wise allocation made during the last four years including current year is given in Annexure I.
- (c): A statement showing achievements made under major components of NBM during last three years and current year is given in Annexure II.
- (d) & (e): The bamboo sector will continue to be supported by the Government.
