REFUND OF FEES

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the students who had applied to Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) but later opted out, have not been refunded the fees deposited by them;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has issued any instruction to the IITs in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (e) Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) for admissions in Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) is decided and conducted by the Joint Admission Board (JAB). During JEE-2010, The Government had received some representations for refund of fee which were forwarded to the organizing Institute for JEE. The Chairman JEE-2011 has informed that since the IITs do not maintain a waiting list of candidates for filling vacancies, refund of fees is not given to the candidates.
