- (b): As per a recent study got conducted by the Ministry of Urban Development through M/s Wilbur Smith Associates Pvt. Ltd., the total requirement of funds for urban transport in 87 identified cities by 2030 is roughly estimated at Rs.4,35,380 crore.
- (c) & (d): The State-wise details of Bus Rapid Transit System (BRTS) projects approved under JNNURM and funds/assistance provided by Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India for their implementation are at Annexure I. The details of Metro Rail Projects implemented/under implementation in various cities and funds released therefor during the last three years are given at Annexure II & III respectively.
