- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) & (b): As per the Master Plans of the Cities prepared by the concerned State Governments, the projected population for 2021 is given as under:-

Delhi 230 Lakh Mumbai 142 - 163 Lakh Kolkata 199 Lakh Chennai 111.97 Lakh Bengaluru 100 Lakh Hyderabad 136 Lakh

(c) to (e): The master plan for Delhi stands notified. Ministry of Urban Development does not propose to put in place a master plan for Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru and Hyderabad as it falls in the purview of States and cities concerned.
