RETIRED AYURVEDIC DOCTORS IN CGHS DISPENSARIES

**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government proposes to appoint retired ayurvedic doctors on contract basis in Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) dispensaries;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor;
- (c) the proposed terms and conditions for these appointments; and
- (d) the time such appointments are likely to be done?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI GHULAM NABIAZAD)

(a): Yes.

(b) & (c): The appointment will be for a maximum of two years or till the doctor attains the age of 62 years, whichever is earlier. The doctors to be appointed a contract basis would be paid a lump sum amount not exceeding Rs. 46,000/- (Rupees Forty Six Thousand only) per month.

(d): The appointments are likely to be made in about four months time.
