The Government is implementing Nutrient Based Subsidy (NBS) Policy for decontrolled Phosphatic & Potassic fertilizers with effect from 1,4.2010 (w.e.f. 1.5.2010 for SSP) during 2010-11. This scheme has been allowed to continue during 2011-12. The detail of Nutrient Based Subsidy during 2010-11 and 2011-12 is as per Annexure-1.
