- (f) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) & (b): The Ministry of Environment and Forests is implementing the National Afforestation Programme (NAP),a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, in the country including Gujarat. The programme is aimed at regeneration of degraded forests and adjoining areas through a two-tier decentralized set-up of Forest Development Agencies (FDAs) at Forest Division level and Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMCs) at village level.
- (c): The State-wise funds released under NAP during the last three years are given in the annexure.
- (d): The implementation of the programme is monitored at the national level by National Level Steering Committee and at the State level by State Level Steering Committee.
- (e): The programme does not provide for free plantation.
- (f): Does not rise.
