(a): Yes, Madam.

(b&c): After BGML was declared sick and closed in 2001, the Govt. constituted a committee comprising of officers form Mineral Exploration Corporation Ltd, Indian Bureau of Mines, and Geological Survey of India in 2005. The committee was assigned the job of valuation of assets of the company. The work of exploration and assessment of gold reserves at KGF was not in scope of the committee. No other committee was appointed for the purpose.
