(a)&(b): At present there is no proposal to construct new FCI godown in any Southern States. However, under the five year guarantee Scheme for construction of godowns for FCI – Storage Requirement through Private entrepreneurs – 2008, the High Level committee has approved creation of storage capacity of 4.71 lakh tonnes for the Southern States as per the details given at Annexure.
