(a)to (d): The Union Cabinet in its meeting held on November 18, 2010 approved the establishment of an Independent Evaluation Office (IEO) to undertake impartial and objective assessment of the outcomes and impact of the major flagship programmes of the Government of India. The IEO will be an independent office attached to the Planning Commission under a Governing Board chaired by the Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission. The IEO will strengthen the existing evaluation process by drawing the best resources available from leading research organizations. The findings of the independent evaluation will be reported to the Government of India and also be placed in the public domain.
