(a)to(d) Details of road projects taken up under Public Private Partnership mode during the XI Plan under National Highways Development Project are enclosed at Annexure-I. Allocation of funds is made for different phases of National Highways Development Project. Maximum permissible VGF is 40% of the total project cost for BOT (Toll) projects, for the projects on BOT (Annuity) mode semi-annual annuity payments are released to the preferred bidder, on the basis of competitive bidding. The Public Private Partnership projects on National Highways undertaken in States are supported by the concerned State Government by signing MoU/State Support Agreement
