- (a): The details of the Scheme for Integrated Textile/Jute Parks (SITP) alongwith the number of projects pending/sanctioned with their locations and funds allocated/utilised so far under the scheme in the country, State and Union Territory-wise are placed at Annexure-I.
- (b): Yes Madam, this Ministry has received 55 proposals to set up new parks.
- (c): Details of 55 proposals received during the last two years, State Union Territory-wise is placed at Annexure-II
- (d) & (e): Yes Madam, Finance Minister in his budget speech 2010-11 had announced an Additional Central Assistance (ACA) of Rs.200 crores to the Government of Tamil Nadu towards the cost of Installation of Zero Liquid Discharge system at Tirupur to sustain the Textiles Cluster for Knitwear. The first instalment of the ACA of Rs.100 crores was released to the Government of Tamil Nadu in September 2010 by Ministry of Finance.
