- (b) the steps taken by the Government to check the use of plastic products in the country?

(a) & (b): According to a survey of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) in 2008, plastic consumption in India was 8 million tonnes per annum. Ministry of Environment and Forests has notified the Plastic Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 (amended on 02.07.2011) which, inter-alia, require municipal authorities to set up, operationalise and coordinate the waste management system and ensure proper collection, storage, segregation, transportation, processing and disposal of plastic waste.
