Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a huge difference in the actual number of vehicles passing through toll plazas and actual number reported by the concessionaire on National Highways;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the estimated loss of revenue reported during each of the last three years;
- (c) the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government has any proposal regarding installation of Automatic Vehicle Counter cum Classifiers (AVCCs) on all lanes of toll plazas in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

- (a to c) No, Madam. There is no such report of huge difference in the actual number of vehicles passing through the toll plazas and actual number of vehicles reported by the concessionaire on National Highways.
- (d) & (e) As per Model Concession Agreement, the Automatic Vehicle Counter cum Classifiers (AVCCs) is to be provided on toll plazas of all National Highways being developed to two-lane paved shoulder/ four-lane/ six-lane, on B.O.T. basis.
