- (a) & (b) PM met Prime Minister of Pakistan on the sidelines of the NAM Summit in Sharm-El-Sheikh on 16-7-09 and both leaders agreed that the two countries will share real-time, credible and actionable information on any future terrorist threats.
- (c) If real-time, credible and actionable information were received from Pakistan, it could be of utility in countering terrorist threats.
