Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Maoists are making efforts to formulate a safe passage/hideouts from Bengal to Chhattisgarh to carry out their activities;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the maoists are also using, the Indo-Bangladesh border where fencing is still incomplete to save themselves from security forces;

(d) whether there are a number of hidden camps of maoists in Sudarban, Diamond Harbour and Kakdwip Islands in the State of West Bengal; and

(e) if so, the action being taken by the Government to dismantle such hideouts?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (c): There are no specific inputs indicating CPI (Maoist) making efforts to link-up their hideouts in West Bengal with those in Chhattisgarh and using Bangladesh border to save themselves from securithy forces. But it is a common tactic of CPI (Maoist) cadres to operate across State boundaries.

(d) & (e): There are no inputs indicating presence of such camps of the CPI (Maoist) in sundarban, Diamond Harbour and Kakdwip Islands in West Bengal.
