- (d) the extent to which the relations between the two countries have further strengthened as a result thereof?

(a) to (d) Foreign Secretary paid an official visit to Nepal from January 18-20, 2011, during which she called on the President of Nepal, the Prime Minister of Nepal, Speaker of the Constituent Assembly, Deputy Prime Minister & Foreign Minister and Deputy Prime Minister & Minister of Physical Planning & Works and the Foreign Secretary of Nepal. The focus of the meetings was to strengthen the relations between the two countries. The Indian delegation held delegation-level talks with the Nepalese side.
