- (a) whether the Government proposes to relax the norms for opening branches of post offices in hilly areas in comparison to plain areas in the country;

- (a) & (b) In the existing guidelines for opening of new post offices, there is already relaxation in the norms for opening of post offices in hilly areas in comparison to plain areas. There is no proposal for further relaxation in the existing norms.
