- (b) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken to put this train into use/operation?

(a) to (c): A Duronto service between Amritsar and Chandigarh which was announced for introduction in the year 2010-11 has not been introduced as its rake consisting of coaching stock hitherto not used for running passenger trains on Indian Railways was awaiting mandatory safety clearances. The mandatory safety clearances for running the new type of coaching stock have since been obtained and the service will be introduced shortly.
