Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a Railway Station on the World heritage Shimla- Kalka Railway route was gutted in a devastating fire recently;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the estimated loss of revenue caused to the Railways as a result thereof;
- (c) whether the Railways have taken any steps to restore the said railway station back to its original glory;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reason therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H.MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) and (b) On 03.05.2011 at about 01.45 Hrs. fire broke out at Kanda Ghat railway station building in Kalka Shimla route of Northern Railway. Fire brigade from Solan attended the site at 03.05 hrs and controlled the fire at 07.45 hrs. As a result of fire, the station building, one staff quarter, railway canteen and other infrastructure have been completely damaged. The loss has been assessed to Rs. 50 lakhs (approximately).
- (c) to (e): Consultancy for engaging an architect to reconstruct the Railway Station building maintaining its authenticity with regard to heritage has been initiated.
