(a): As per available estimates, the total cultivable land is 182.71 million ha. (2006-07) in the country. The State-wise details are annexed.

(b) & (c): As per the Seventh Schedule of the Constitution of India, Land falls under the purview of the State Governments and, therefore, it is for the State Governments to bring suitable legislation to protect diversion and change in land uses of agricultural land.
