- (a) the major rivers flowing in India and the places of their origin;
- (b) the details of State-wise distance covered by these rivers beginning from their origin till the sea and the State-wise area being irrigated by each river, especially in Himachal Pradesh;
- (c) whether there is any dispute over the distribution of the waters of the river Satluj between any of the States; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) The details of major rivers flowing in India, the places of their origin with State-wise distance covered by these rivers beginning from their origin till the sea is attached at Annexure I. State-wise area being irrigated by each river has not been calculated so far. However, State-wise details of gross irrigated area is attached at annexure-II.
- (c) & (d) There is no information regarding any dispute between any of the States over the distribution of the waters of river Sutlej.
