(a) to (c): A Meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Union Home Minister on 4th July 2011 to review the current operational scenario in Left Wing Extremism affected states, which, among others, was attended by Directors General of Police of these states, DGs of Central Armed Police Forces and other officials. During the meeting, a number of issues concerning anti-naxal operations and development schemes were discussed. Such review meetings are held periodically to monitor Left Wing Extremism (LWE) situation.
