(a) & (b): To make an assessment regarding transfer of food subsidy in cash, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi has reported the launch of a pilot project in Raghubir Nagar in West Delhi. The results of the study are awaited. Proposals have also been received by the Government from some State Governments like Bihar, Delhi, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh for direct disbursement of food subsidy in cash to Below Poverty Line (BPL)/ Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) families on pilot basis instead of distribution of foodgrains to them under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS). A draft scheme is under examination.
