- (a) & (b): A Core Working Group of experts, constituted by the Director General of Health Services (DGHS) has formulated guidelines for preparing an Action Plan for the states to implement a program for Prevention and Control of Sickle Cell Anaemia, Thalassemia and Haemophilia.
- (c): The Plan of Action on Genetic Blood Disorders including Sickle Cell disease would be considered for formulating 12th Five year Plan for non-communicable diseases and shall be submitted to the Planning Commission.
