- (b) if so, the details thereof crop-wise?

(a) & (b): No, Madam. The Statutory Minimum Price (SMP) is fixed for Sugarcane only. For other cash crops, such as Cotton, Jute, etc., Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) are fixed. The MSPs fixed by the Government for Cotton and Jute for 2007-08 and 2008-09 are as follows:

Crop Variety 2007-08 2008-09

Cotton Medium Staple 1800 2500

Long Staple 2030 3000

Jute 1055 1250
