- (c): No, Madam. Though, the betel leaves growers are small land holders, they are getting sufficient returns.
- (d) to (f): Betel leaf is covered under agricultural crops. The Government of India has been implementing two Centrally Sponsored Schemes viz., Technology Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture in North Eastern States including Sikkim, Uttarakhand, J&K and Himachal Pradesh (TMNE) and National Horticulture Mission (NHM) for the remaining states for holistic development of horticultural crops including betelleaf duly ensuring an end to end approach covering production and post harvest management.
