(a) to (e): Yes Sir. The Central Government had constituted an Expert Committee to review the functioning of Defense and Strategic Studies related Departments in the university system. Based on the report, the University Grants Commission (UGC) constituted a Committee under the Chairmanship of Air Commodore (retd) Jasjit Singh, former Director, Institute of Defence Studies & Analyses (IDSA) to workout the extent of financial commitments for setting up a National level Council of National Security Research and Studies corresponding broadly with Council for Scientific & Industrial Research (CSIR). The Report is under examination.
